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stephen eric bronner is a prolific author activist and one of america s leading political thinkers his new book presents bigotry as a systematic all encompassing mindset that has a special affinity for right wing movements in what will surely prove a seminal study bronner explores its appeal the self image it justifies the interests it serves and its complex connection with modernity he reveals how prejudice shapes the conspiratorial and paranoid worldview of the true believer the elitist and the chauvinist in the process it becomes apparent how the bigot hides behind mainstream conservative labels in order to support policies designed to disadvantage the targets of his contempt examining bigotry in its various dimensions anthropological historical psychological sociological and political professor bronner illustrates how the bigot s intense hatred of the other is a direct reaction to social progress liberal values secularism and an increasingly complex

and diverse world a sobering look at the bigot in the twenty first century this volume is essential for making sense of the dangers facing democracy now and in the future

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long after the end of the civil war the civil rights movement of the 1960s desegregation in the schools the abolition of anti asian legislation and the women s movement the pernicious effects of prejudice and discrimination in u s society are still evident despite efforts to eradicate the injustice against people based on race ethnicity gender disability or other elements prejudice and discrimination remain in most cases the display is more covert than in years past today the united states is embroiled in battles regarding gay rights bias and disparities in services opportunities and practices affect quality of life health and mental health for all peoples in these volumes focused on the psychology at issue experts from across the nation and in different fields examine the state of prejudice and discrimination in america today and each offers practical direction that can be taken by individuals communities and officials to create a more just society each chapter offers a toolbox of information on how to cope how to keep oneself whole how to seek validation of identity how to raise children to dispel unfair images and perceptions and how to work for societal change

linguistics medicine population studies psychology religion and sociology each entry is followed by a listing of suggested readings and suggested resources and also links to related terms within the whole book outstanding features the book adopts a biopsychosocial historical approach to the topics covered in the chapters and the entries each entry includes suggested readings and suggested resources the chapters and entries are written graduate level that is accessible to all academics researchers and professionals from diverse backgrounds we consider the audience for the entries to be well educated but a non expert in this area the primary focus of the book is on the immigrant populations in and immigration to magnet countries references are made to worldwide trends and issues arising globally in addition to the comprehensive subject coverage the text also offers diverse perspectives the editors themselves reflect the multidisciplinary nature of the topics with expertise in psychiatry law epidemiology anthropology and social work authors similarly reflect diverse disciplines
